WHO ARE WE?

WHAT DOES IT COST?

Full Share————\$580 / 16 weeks

Full Work Share- \$400 / 16 weeks

Half Share————\$340 / 8 weeks

Half Work Share \$250 / 8 weeks

Work Shares require 2 hours of work per week in the garden during the harvest season (16 weeks), plus six hours in the planting season (April 15th-May 30th). Total of 38 working hours.

Half Work Shares require 2 hours of work every other week in the garden during the harvest season (8 weeks), plus six hours in the planting season (April 15th-May 30th). Total of 22 working hours.
