A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is due at time of sign up. The remaining membership fee is due **by May 15th**. All payments (cash/check) are non-refundable. Payment plans may be arranged.

Work Times: 9am – 2pm Monday – Friday, 10am - noon Saturdays, Saturday work days preseason and postseason, usually 9am-2pm. All working shares with a Saturday pick-up should work 10 am- noon Saturday. 8 week shares owe 22 hours of work, 16 week shares owe 38 hours of work.

Pick-up days/times: Working and non-working share pick up times are noon Saturdays and 2pm-8pm Monday, Wednesday, or Thursday (exact time to be arranged).

Volunteer hours: The CSA asks for volunteer work hours, with the express wish that all members (working and non-working shares) will volunteer. There will be start of the season planting Saturdays, as well as season-long work times Monday through Saturday and an end of season clean-up day. For the CSA to work as the community it has become, and to keep professional costs to a minimum, the CSA really needs your help out there. Volunteer hours do not contribute to working hours.

We are a non-profit organization. Members of the CSA management team put in hundreds of volunteer hours each year to make the garden work. All membership fees are used to pay garden expenses. Membership fees are distributed this way: 15% for rent, 10% seeds and garden supplies, 25% improvements and maintenance, 50% labor, and 5% for other incidental costs.

I understand that I am buying a harvest share of the produce of the Upland Hills CSA, not a specific amount of produce. I am entitled, though, to my equal share of the CSA production. I understand that there are risks involved in farming and that some part of the produce may be un-harvestable, and I am willing to share those risks with this CSA in order to secure my food source.
